

## OFFICE CONSOLIDATION

This document represents the Office Consolidation of By-law 88-51, a By-law to prohibit the sale of certain confections upon any highway with the Town of Caledon, and has been prepared for reference purposes only. Reference should be made to the Town Clerk for original by-laws.

### THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF CALEDON

#### BY-LAW 88-51

Being a By-law to prohibit the sale of  
certain confections upon any highway  
within the Town of Caledon

The Council of the Corporation of the Town of Caledon enacts as follows:

#### DEFINITIONS

"collector road" means a road as defined in the Official Plan of the Corporation of the Town of Caledon, as amended

"ice cream truck" means a motor vehicle as defined under the *Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. H.8, as amended, from which ice cream, ice cream products, iced or frozen confections or desserts are sold

"local road" means a road as defined in the Official Plan of the Corporation of the Town of Caledon, as amended

"regional road" means a road under the jurisdiction of the Regional Municipality of Peel

"settlement area" means an area as defined in the Official Plan of the Corporation of the Town of Caledon, as amended

"Town" means the Corporation of the Town of Caledon"

#### GENERAL

1. Notwithstanding section 7.10 of By-law 95-52, as amended no person shall sell any candy, peanuts, popcorn, ice cream, ice cream cones, iced or frozen milk, or iced or frozen confections or desserts, hot dogs, hamburgers, fish and chips or french fries from any cart, wagon, bicycle or motor vehicle upon any highway in the Town of Caledon.
2. This By-law shall not apply to a person who owns or operates an ice cream truck which is operated in accordance with the following regulations.
  - 2A. A person shall not operate an ice cream truck:
    - (a) on a collector road or local road;
    - (b) on a regional road;
    - (c) in a Town park without written permission from the Town;
    - (d) on private property without written permission from the property owner;

- (e) within thirty (30) metres of any intersection;
  - (f) within one hundred (100) metres of any public or private school property during the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on any regular school day;
  - (g) for more than fifteen (15) minutes at a time at any specific location;
  - (h) at a specific location within two (2) hours of a previous attendance at that same location; or
  - (i) between the hours of 8:00 p.m. one day and 8:00 a.m. the following day while ringing bells, chimes or any other recognizable sounds, notwithstanding By-law 86-110.
3. Any person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence.
4. By-law 87-63 shall be and is hereby repealed.
