**OPP HOT SPOTS** – Caledon OPP have identified 10 areas in our Town requiring intensive OPP activity for traffic enforcement. I am providing them to you, with the knowledge of the OPP Inspector. Please **slow down** in all areas of our town but be particularly careful in the following areas:

- Highway 9 between Highway 10 and Airport Road
- Charleston Sideroad between Shaws Creek Road and Kennedy Road
- Highway 10 between Escarpment Sideroad and Olde Base Line Road
- Highway 50 between Highway 9 and Patterson Sideroad
- Airport Road between Patterson Sideroad and Olde Base Line Road
- King Street between Highway 10 and Airport Road
- Highway 10 between King Street and Mayfield Road
- Airport road between King Street and Mayfield Road
- The Gore road between King Street and Mayfield Road
- Highway 50 between King Street and Mayfield Road
- Highway 50 between Castlederg Sideroad and Mayfield Road
- **Seasonal** – Forks of the Credit between Mississauga road and Highway 10.
