

By-law

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF CALEDON

BY-LAW 87-101

(for prohibiting the throwing or placing of refuse or debris on highways and bridges)


WHEREAS paragraph 1 of section 315 of the Municipal Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 302, as amended) authorizes the council of all municipalities to pass by-laws for prohibiting or regulating the obstructing, encumbering, injuring or fouling of highways or bridges;


AND WHEREAS paragraph 5 of section 315 of the Municipal Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 302, as amended) authorizes the council of all municipalities to pass by-laws for prohibiting the throwing, placing or depositing of dirt, filth, glass, handbills, paper or other rubbish or refuse, or the carcass of any animal, on any highway or bridge;

NOW THEREFORE the council of The Corporation of the Town of Caledon ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. No person shall obstruct, encumber, injure or foul, or permit to be obstructed, encumbered, injured or fouled, any highway or bridge under the jurisdiction of the Town of Caledon.
2. No person shall throw, place or deposit, or permit to be thrown, placed or deposited, on any highway or bridge under the jurisdiction of the Town of Caledon, dirt, filth, glass, handbills, paper or other rubbish or refuse, or the carcass of any animal.
3. Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence, and liable, upon conviction, to a fine of not more than \$2,000.00, exclusive of costs, in respect of each offence.
4. By-law 85-72 is hereby repealed.
