



## NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION

### Kennedy Road Improvement Class Environmental Assessment (from Mayfield Road, north 800 m)

The Town of Caledon has completed a Class Environmental Assessment to investigate various improvements to Kennedy Road, from Mayfield Road to the southern limits of the Mayfield West Community Development Area, a distance of approximately 800 m (ref. Key Plan). Improvements to Kennedy Road are necessary to meet the projected increase in traffic demand as a result of development of the Mayfield West Community.

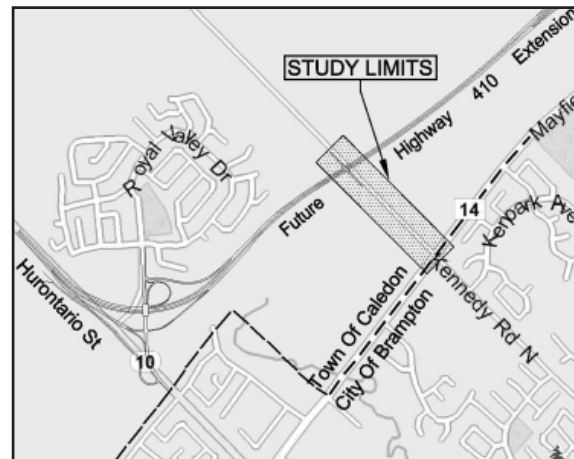
The Town of Caledon intends to reconstruct Kennedy Road to an urban cross section consisting of two 3.5 m lanes and two 4.25 m shared curb lanes, with a 1.5 m sidewalk on the east side and a 3.0 m multi-use path on the west side. Left turn lanes will be constructed at intersections. An overpass crossing the proposed Highway 410 extension will be constructed by the Ministry of Transportation. The study was conducted in compliance with Schedule "C" of the Municipal Engineers Association *Municipal Class Environmental Assessments (June 2000)*. An Environmental Study Report (ESR) has been prepared and is available for public review at the following locations:

Please provide written comments to the Town of Caledon or the consulting engineer, Philips Engineering Ltd., by November 20, 2006. If concerns regarding this project cannot be resolved through discussions with Town of Caledon staff, a person or party may request that the Minister of the Environment order the project to comply with Part II of the *Environmental Assessment Act* (referred to as a Part II Order). Requests for a Part II Order must be received by the Minister in writing at the address provided below. A copy of the request must also be sent to the Senior Transportation Planner for the Town of Caledon. If no request is received by November 20, 2006, the Town of Caledon intends to proceed with detailed design and construction.
