FIREWORKS REMINDER

With Victoria Day and Canada Day celebrations behind us, many homeowners enjoyed fireworks displays on their own property. However, as we approach another summer long weekend, Caledon Fire & Emergency Services would like to remind residents that, in this municipality, Victoria Day and Canada Day are the only permitted days for discharging fireworks on private property.

The Town's Firework Bylaw #2009-097 states that a permit is required to sell fireworks 10 days prior to Victoria Day and Canada Day each calendar year, and that fireworks cannot be sold at any other time of the year. Discharging fireworks on any other day is in contravention of the by-law and is subject to a fine.
